Nanabah Aragon is a traditional Dine (Navajo) weaver who was declared a “living treasure” by the State of Arizona. Her weavings have been on display at the Heard and Smithsonian museums.

She will teach you the basics of Navajo weaving as you create your own sample and learn the techniques passed on from Nanabah’s mother and grandmother.

- Each two – day workshop is limited to 6 people.
- Class fee: \$200.00 Includes the 12” x 15” hand loom plus weaving tools and wool.
